Postal and Delivery System Locks

1 Electronic Latchlock

This lock is fitted to the interior of the parcel or mailbox and can integrate with existing, or be used as, a standalone system. With a simple push to lock action, the lock can be operated using an i-button, proximity card or key pad.

2 Camlocks

This is the most versatile lock in the range and is often used to secure keyed mail and postboxes. Many of our Camlocks have been specifically designed for outdoor and cold temperature use and can withstand temperatures as low as -40°.

3 Lever Locks

These locks are very secure and use anti-pick levers in place of tumblers. The lock is normally fitted to the rear of the door so only the keyhole is visible when locked.

4 Digital Locks

Our range of digital locks eliminates the need for keys and vastly reduces associated costs. With many different designs and features, these adaptable locks are supplied with a choice of cams to suit. Some of our digital locks can be used with the RAS system and all come with a key override as standard.

5 Horizon Lock

The Horizon digital lock is a slimline, small footprint lock with real-time and audit capabilities. Easy to install and simple to operate, the lock is available in Public, Private, Multiuser or Remote Allocation (RAS) operating modes as standard. Using the infra-red interface enables users auditing and activity logging. The lock also comes with a unique mechanical override key that permits managerial access in the event of an emergency.

6 Remote Allocation System (RAS)

This system works with all of our digital locks, enabling you to remotely manage access in your mail and parcel collection point without the need to go to site. Remote management is via a simple web based system which can be accessed from any location with the usual range of desk based and hand-held devices.
